The City of Casselberry Community Development Department will be hosting a workshop to solicit public input for the process of updating the City's Comprehensive Plan. The City welcomes all citizens to attend the workshop to learn more about proposed updates to the Comprehensive Plan and provide input related to those issues of importance to the Community.

Background:

Every governmental jurisdiction in the State of Florida must have a Comprehensive Planning document that guides how that community will grow. This document analyzes data specific to the existing conditions and growth of that community and uses this data to create goals, objectives and policies that will ensure the community grows in a way that protects the health, safety and welfare of its citizens.

In accordance with Florida Statutes, once every seven years, each jurisdiction must evaluate its Comprehensive Plan to determine whether it complies with current statutory requirements and evaluate how successfully the document is implementing the goals and priorities of the community.

The City of Casselberry's process of updating its Comprehensive Plan is currently underway and this open-house style workshop will provide a forum for citizens of Casselberry to be involved in this effort.
